right up!



2017 started with unusually high water and stayed high all year long. The docks behind the office were under water till mid August and we

had to raise the walkway through the swamp to the floating docks, however we had no problem getting out to the lake. Most state boat launches were closed but we didn't have any problems with ours. Even with the high water, the fishing was the best it's been in quite a few years.

Spring brown trout fishing was excellent with plenty of lakers and steelies being caught. The browns were caught most of the year with plenty in the 10 lb range. Midsummer fishing was average with a mixed bag of browns, steelies, lakers and salmon. August and September were the best fishing in the last 5 years and should be just as good this year. September was coho crazy with limits of above average size fish that lasted almost into October.

The fall salmon run started a little early due to the high water but the fishing was good into early November. There were over 1000 fished cleaned at Catfish Creek the month of October. People fished the creek till the end of November catching nice browns, steelies and a few salmon.

The Summer Customer Appreciation Weekend will be June 22rd - 24th with a special rate - if you stay 2 nights you will get the 2nd night at half price! We will provide roasted chicken (or pork) for the picnic on Saturday. Please bring a covered dish and your favorite beverage to the picnic. This is also NY's

Free Fishing Weekend which means you do not need to purchase a fishing license for Saturday or Sunday. Plus, bass season will be open.

The Fall Customer Appreciation Picnic will be Saturday, September 1st. Again, please bring a covered dish and your favorite beverage; we will provide the roasted meat.
